Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG) - Buergical Cleansing

WHAT IS CHLORHEXIDINE GLUCONATE

Chlorhexidine Gluconate (CHG 24%) is an antimicrobial agent that is used as aspinegical skin cleanser. It kills bacteria and othegerms and inhibits the growth of new germs. As a patient, you play an important role in preparing your skin for surgery. Using CHG, as directed herein, will help reduce your chance of developing a su site infection.

HOW TO USE CHLORHEXIDINE GLUCONAT

before the seond evening shower.

SHOWERING

TWO CONSECUTIVE NIGHTS BEFORE SURGERY:

- 1. While in the shower, wash your hair and body with regular shampoo and soap. Rinse off shampoo and soap completely. This is very important since shampoo and soap can reduce the effectiveness of CHG.
- 2. How to apply the liquid solution of CHG on your body. Use one bottle for 3 showers.
 - xPour 1/3rd of liquid CHG solution onto a clean damp washcloth. DO NOT dilute the CHG solution.
 - xStep away from the water stream or turn off the water while washing with CHGwlhiprevent rinsing off the CHG too soon.
 - xWashyour body from the neck downfront and backtaking care to avoid our genitals, anus, eyes, ears and mouth
 - xAllow the CHG solution to remain on your skin for chinutes.
 - xDuring the wait time, concentrate on the body site where you will have the operations well as, the kin folds, belly button, crevices, feet and between toes (last), as this is a common place for bacterilia to
- 3. Rinse the CHG solution throughly concentrating again on the find folds crevices feet and toes.
- 4. Dry yourself very well using a clean townedluding anyskin folds and feet Use fresh towels for each shower.
- 5. DO NOT use any ointments, lotionspowders after your CHG pseurgical shower. Ointments, lotions or powders will reduce the effectivess of CHG.
- 6. Dressn fresh clean pajamas or comfortable clothinater each shower.

Note: Do not shavewith a razor blade anywhere on your bodyfor three days prior to surgeryShaving with a razor increases your risk of infection when you have surgeElectric shavers are okay to use

THE MORNING OF SURGERY:

xFollow steps 2 thru 4Only use the CHG per the above instructions.

xDO NOT us your regular shampoo or soap in the show and do not apply lotions or deodorant after the last shower Using these products will decrease the effectiveness of the CHG-suegical cleans.

xDress in clean and comfortable clotbin
